

Greasley wins at

Pembrey

JOHN GREASLEY, driving a Porsche, won the sixth round of the Lloyds Bowmaker British Rallycross Championship on the new Pembrey Rallycross track at Llanelli on Sunday by the narrowest of margins.

Greasley, of Amersham, appeared to be in control throughout the five laps final, but the tricky Pembrey track caught him out and allowed the Ford Fiesta of Ashford's Trevor Hopkins to make a last lap challenge.

Hopkins and Greasley crossed the finishing line almost side by side to end the meeting in splendid style.

Trevor Reeves, of Croy-

don, was third and the points gained allowed him to close on championship leader Rob Gibson (Cheshire), who was disqualified during the earlier heats.

With four rounds remaining, Gibson still has a considerable lead, however.

George Warren (Neath) did his best to uphold the Welsh honour in his Ford Escort with a stirring effort which saw him pipped for ninth place on the finishing line.
