

Tim sets out for race title

LAMPETER-BASED
Tim Davies sets off in search of the British Formula Ford 2000 title at Brands Hatch tomorrow in the opening race of the championship.

Davies, who showed good form in last year's Dunlop Stars of Tomorrow race had hoped to drive one of his new Royale cars but problems mean he must revert to a two-year-old car supplied by Roger Cowman.

He finished fourth in last year's championship despite missing the early rounds. He won five races worth £2,500 from the grove-wood Awards Scheme after he had been judged one of the brightest prospects in racing.
